



# MCFOODS Needs Volunteers Monroe Fall Harvest Food Drive

- When:** Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup> 9:00 am
- Where:** Clearbrook / Concordia Adult Communities, Monroe Twp.
- What:** Volunteers will hang a bag with a flyer on the mailbox of each resident promoting the Fall Harvest Food Drive.

Each year the adult communities in Monroe participate in the Fall Harvest Food Drive and bring in about 5 tons of food to benefit MCFOODS. The contributions received through this drive help us keep food on our shelves through the fall to assist the 100 food pantries, soup kitchens and social service agencies in our network.

Volunteers will receive bags, flyers and maps depicting the streets in their designated section ahead of time so that the flyers can be pre-stuffed into the bags at your convenience and save time that morning.

Volunteers will go to their designated section at 9:00 am on Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup> to distribute the materials. The bag with the flyer inside should be hung on the mailbox of each residence in your section. When you have completed your section you may leave. This usually takes 2-3 hours; most volunteers are done by 11:00 or 12:00. If bags are pre-stuffed the actual distribution time may be less.

Volunteers of all ages are welcome; however they must be supervised by a responsible adult with transportation to drive through the community. It is usually best to work in small groups of 2-5 people. Thank you for your anticipated support of MCFOODS.
