STORM WILL SHUT DOWN SOME MCIA OPERATIONS

MIDDLESEX COUNTY – Due to Monday and Tuesday’s impending snow storm, several of the Middlesex County Improvement Authority’s early-and-mid week operations will be suspended.

Recycling pick-up will be cancelled Tuesday for New Brunswick, Sayreville and Spotswood. Depending on the severity of the storm, Wednesday’s schedules may also be affected in Sayreville and Dunellen. Any missed pick-ups are expected to be rescheduled for the following Saturday.

As for the golf courses, Raritan Landing in Piscataway, the Meadows at Middlesex in Plainsboro and Tamarack in East Brunswick will all be closed for play until further notice. Golfing will resume once staff deem that course conditions have improved.

Administrators from the Middlesex County Food Organization and Outreach Distribution Services (MCFOODS) have contacted its registered agencies, soup kitchens, churches and other entities to notify members that this week’s distribution in New Brunswick will be also be cancelled. The next distribution is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday next week.

At present, the public should anticipate that the MCIA’s various offices will be open Tuesday and Wednesday. If this should change for any reason, closures will be announced on the Authority’s website at www.mciauth.com.
